Chaneco is a close-knit family business which has been making footwear since 1971 and is one of the largest independent suppliers of adult stock, modular and bespoke orthopaedic footwear in the UK.

Smart Steps is a complete range of Paediatric footwear and foot orthotics developed with quality and service in mind at the request of our customers. All of our styles are made of high quality heavy leathers, most with stitchdown construction and a rubber commando sole for durability. The trainer styles are made using the more traditional cemented construction but again with rubber bottoms to increase wearability. We offer all styles in sizes 3 (19) to 9½ (44) in 4 different widths along with Stability, Oversplint and Anti Varus options.

All styles are available as modular - with last additions to improve fit or as fully bespoke footwear. As every pair is made to order it allows us the opportunity to fully customise the footwear to the patient's requirements.

Lead Times

Standard and modular footwear including adaptions will be despatched within 10 working days. Bespoke footwear to a draft, scan or casts will be despatched within 15 working days. If you need footwear urgently, please phone us with your requirements and we will endeavour to meet your timescales.




The stability option is available on all styles made on our Regular or Anti-Varus lasts and offers a higher and longer stiffener for increased support

Smart STEPS Inlays



In addition to the standard inlays supplied in the footwear, we are also able to offer a range of alternative inlays manufactured from heat mouldable EVA with a microfibre top cover to fit our footwear perfectly. All inlays are available in all sizes and width fittings with heel cups up to a height of 25mm (please specify when ordering).



Neuro Inlays

- Supports valgus and varus arches
- Neutral heel cup
- Stabilises the metatarsal joints with a moulded metatarsal dome and incorporated dropped hallux
- Wedges, posts and raises can be added for further control



Neutral Inlays

- Supports valgus and varus arches
- Deep neutral heel cup
- Helps to control overpronation by reducing strain and pressure on arches
- Wedges, posts and raises can be added for further control



Anti Pronation Inlays

- Supports valgus and varus arches
- Incorporates a kirby skive and neutral extrinsic post
- Corrects and controls rearfoot
- Wedges, posts and raises can be added for further control

Our standard Arch and Filled Arch Support Inlays both offer extra support to maintain a good biomechanical foot position to help prevent fallen arches, plantar fasciitis and further damage.



Arch Support Inlays

- Available in full and 3/4 lengths
- Supports valgus and varus arches
- Controls moderate overpronation
- Valgus & varus arches can be made up to a height of 25mm
- Wedges, posts and raises can be added for further control




Filled Arch Support Inlays


- Available in full and ¾ lengths
- Supports valgus and varus arches
- Controls higher level overpronation with filled arches
- Valgus & varus arches can be made up to a height of 25mm
- Wedges, posts and raises can be added for further control

How to measure for Smart STEPS footwear

Using a Non Calibrated Foot Stick

- 1. Position the foot on the stick non-weight bearing and move the slider up to the longest toe
- 2. Read the foot length size and add 3 sizes (24mm) to give the shoe size. If measuring weight bearing, add only 2 sizes (16mm) and follow the same process
- 3. Wrap a tape measure around the widest part of the foot and measure the joint circumference at this point (J)
- 4. Next reposition the foot sideways and move the slider up to the widest part of the foot and read the joint width measurement in mm from the back of the stick (A)
- 5. Compare these 3 measures, size first, to the fitting chart opposite and choose the closest shoe width to your measures
- 6. Wrap a tape measure around the instep of the foot and measure the instep circumference at this point (I)
- 7. If ordering boots, wrap a tape measure around the leg where you expect the top of the boot to end and measure the leg circumference at this point (H1)
- 8. Using a small rule measure the depth of the highest toe (B)
- 9. Position the foot sideways on the foot stick to measure the heel width (D) in mm from the back of the stick
- 10. Now compare these 4 measures to the fitting chart opposite to ensure the standard measures are suitable for your patient
- 11. If the measures are not aligned, consider either modular or made to measure footwear as above NB: Measure over the AFO for Oversplint Last

Smart STEPS Fitting Chart

Regular, Stability, Anti-Varus & Oversplint lasts all have a 3mm Inlay Allowance as standard. Footwear is supplied with 1 x Leather covered footbed as standard (Oversplint lasts have 8mm extra width across midfoot & heels & 20mm extra instep circ. to accommodate AFO's)

Sole Units

All stitchdown footwear will be supplied with a hard wearing rubber commando sole in either black or caramel. We also offer a lightweight EVA sole should weight of the footwear be paramount above wearability

All our trainer styles have a cemented construction with either a Side Stitched sole or Trainer Sole depending on the style in either black or white. Both sole units have a rubber bottom which could be changed to lightweight EVA to reduce weight

Looking after Smart STEPS footwear

Waxy Leather - Remove any surface dirt using a damp cloth. Then either use shoe polish on a soft cloth and polish to a shine or use colourless leather balm on a soft clean sponge to cover scuffs and restore to a matt finish.

Bulbuck (Suede) - Before wear, spray with suede protector. Remove any surface dirt with the suede brush or nail brush. Use white vinegar on a soft white cloth to rub any stains, allow to dry completely then brush again. Spray with suede protector.

(N.B. When footwear is new, the very strong colours in the Bulbuck (suede) material may leave some colour marking on furniture and other surfaces).

Glitter & Patent Leather - Remove any dirt using a damp cloth & use patent cleaner or petroleum jelly on a soft cloth and polish to a shine.

Terms & Conditions

Urgent Orders - Please phone us with your requirements if you need footwear urgently and we'll endeavour to meet your timescales

Trial Fitting Service - We offer a free trial fitting service on modular and made to measure footwear, allowing for small alterations to be made before finishing. Any additional fittings may be chargeable. Footwear will be invoiced if not returned within 90 days.

Despatch - All Smart Steps footwear, including special orders will be despatched within 2 weeks. (Made to measure 3 weeks). UK despatch will be by next working day courier.

Split Size / Fitting - As all our footwear is made to order, there is no additional charge for split sizes or fittings.

Returns - Rocket style in black waxy leather with either lace or Velcro fastenings made on regular lasts is returnable for full credit. All other footwear is made to order and is non-returnable including split size/width footwear.

Conditions of Sale - Confirmation of telephone or faxed orders should be clearly marked confirmation to avoid duplication. The company reserves the right to alter specifications or withdraw styles without prior notification. All goods remain the property of Chaneco until paid for in full.
